Notice to Registrants of Dicamba-Containing Agricultural Herbicide Products

Effective April 30, 2018 classified all pesticide products containing only dicamba, and having agricultural use labels, are classified as Restricted Use Pesticides (RUPs) in South Dakota by the South Dakota Department of Agriculture (SDDA). This includes over-the-counter herbicides that were previously sold to unlicensed applicators and producers. Since these products have been classified as RUPs by the State of South Dakota but not by the federal government, they will not display the Restricted Use Pesticide legend on the label. A list of 2018 registered products impacted by this new classification has been attached and can also be found on the SDDA's website, sdda.sd.gov, by clicking on the "Dicamba Information" link under the "Happening Now section. A list of frequently asked questions and answers can be found below:

- 1.What does the RUP classification mean to my company if we offer these products for sale in South Dakota in 2018 and beyond? Any retailer that offers to sell or distribute these RUPs directly to end users (certified applicators) in South Dakota must have a *Restricted Use Pesticide Dealer Registration* issued by the SDDA. To learn more about how to become a registered South Dakota RUP dealer visit the SDDA web site sdda.sd.gov, and look for "Pesticide Program" under the Ag Services tab.
- 2. Can I sell these pesticide as over the counter product to anyone? No. These dicamba products may only be sold to certified applicators licensed by the SDDA to purchase and use RUPs. Commercial applicators must have the categories General (G) and 1A Herbicide. Private applicators must be certified to purchase and apply RUPs.
- 3. What sales records are we required to keep for these products? The following sales records must be kept for three years; (1) dealer name, address, and dealer number; (2) name, address, and license number of certified applicator; (3) date of sale; (4) trade name; (5) EPA registration number of the product sold; and (6) quantity sold.
- 4. Do these regulatory requirements also apply to the new dicamba formulations Engenia, FeXapan, and Xtendimax? Yes, these products are not only state RUPs, they are also federal RUPs, effective October, 2017.
- 5. What if my company does not sell or distribute these herbicides directly to end users in South Dakota?

If you do not sell or distribute these product(s) directly to end users (certified applicators), you do not need to become a registered RUP dealer. However, you should advise your customers who may sell or distribute to South Dakota end users of the need to become registered dealers.

- 6. Can non-certified applicators purchase these state RUP herbicides outside of South Dakota and bring them into South Dakota for application? Non-certified applicators may purchase these products from dealers located outside of South Dakota if allowable in the state where the sale occurred, but the applicator may not legally apply the product in South Dakota without the proper certification. A South Dakota dealer may be held accountable for unlawful distribution if it is determined that the dealer knowingly supplied the RUP to an South Dakota applicator, who intends to apply the product without the proper certification.
