
ARx Zinc 10% is a solution of nitrogen and zinc intended for the addition of zinc to polyphosphate and nitrogen fertilizers such as 10-34-0 and UAN 28-0-0. Do not add to fertilizers high in orthophosphate. ARx Zinc 10% is recommended for the prevention and correction of nutrient deficiency in crops.

FIRST AID

IISE RATE

For soil applications in field and row crops or vegetables, add 0.5 to 4 quarts per acre at time of planting. For foliar applications in field and row crops or vegetables, add 1-2 quarters per acre post emergence.

STORAGE AND DISPOSAL

Storage: Store in cool, dry, well-ventilated area, preferably in a locked storage area away from children, feed and food products, and seed. Keep containers tightly closed when not in use. Do not store in aluminum, mild steel, or brass containers.

Disposal: Do not reuse container. Do not contaminate water, food, or feed by storage or disposal. Triple rinse (or equivalent) container, then offer for recycling at an ACRC site (go to http://www.agrecycling.org/) or dispose of empty containers in accordance with local, state, and federal regulations.
